

OUR HEALTH PLANS

We offer a choice of 3 different plans to suit the way you care for your horse.

All of our plans include vaccinations to protect against Flu, Tetanus and Herpes infections. They also include FREE visit fees (the number of free visits included per year varies by plan).

Our Select and Premium plans include an annual blood test to detect developing internal problems at an early stage. Both of these plans also include a 10% discount off our other fees for your horse.

Our Premium plan completes the full preventative health care by adding a comprehensive parasite testing programme. If the testing indicates that worming is required then a suitable wormer is supplied at no extra cost.

VACCINATIONS

"Prevention is better than cure"

All of our health plans include vaccination to provide the best possible protection against the common respiratory viruses of horses (flu and herpes).

The standard vaccines also provide protection against tetanus which is caused by a bacteria found in the soil and can enter a horse via cuts and wounds.

The BASIC plan includes a single yearly booster vaccination for flu (and tetanus on alternate years) plus a herpes booster every 6 months. The SELECT and PREMIUM plans also include an initial / restart course of vaccinations if necessary.

In addition, if you travel to competitions which require 6 monthly flu boosters then these are also included on the SELECT and PREMIUM plans at no extra cost.

Strangles is another common respiratory disease which spreads easily between horses. All of our plans include a discount on the strangles vaccination.

PRICES AND JOINING

To join our health plan, simply call the surgery on (01423) 862121 and our receptionists will set it all up for you.

A one-off joining fee of £10 is charged for new direct debits. All fees and benefits apply to a single named horse. All fees include VAT.

All plans are an auto-renewing 12 month contract paid monthly by direct debit. Each plan includes substantial discounts compared with purchasing the same services at our usual prices. If you cancel your plan or direct debit early, you may be charged an extra fee to cover the full cost of the goods and services already supplied. Prices are reviewed periodically and may change at any time, including mid-contract. You will be notified before any price change is applied.

ANNUAL BLOOD TEST

"Things you can't see are also important"

The SELECT and PREMIUM health plans include the collection of an annual blood sample to monitor the internal health of your horse and provide an early warning of problems developing.

Each test measures 42 parameters checking for signs of anaemia, infection, kidney or liver disease and electrolyte balance.

Normal results provide a valuable baseline for comparison of the results from future tests whilst any abnormal results can highlight hidden problems at an early stage.

The annual blood test is also an ideal opportunity to add other optional health screening tests for example ACTH in older or overweight horses at risk of developing laminitis caused by PPE (Cushings disease).

(Optional tests may incur additional charges)



VISIT FEES INCLUDED

All of our plans include the visits needed to provide all of the elements included in the plan at no extra charge.

There are also extra visits included in case you need to see us for other reasons in the year.

The number of visits included varies between the plans.

The PREMIUM plan includes UNLIMITED visits.

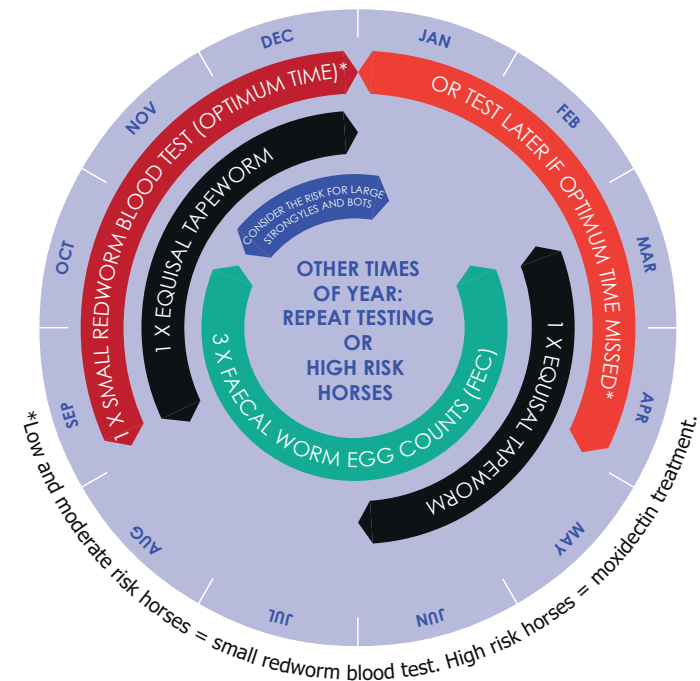
And there are extra discounts off our other products and services included with our SELECT and PREMIUM plans.

WORM TESTING

"Parasites cannot exist without a compliant host"

The PREMIUM health plans provide a fully managed worm testing programme. And, if worm testing indicates that a treatment is required then an appropriate treatment is also included.

Each spring, you will be sent a package of worm test collection kits including two saliva swabs for tapeworm testing and three faecal collection kits for worm eggs.



We will send you reminders by text or email when it's time to collect a sample. Once you've collected the sample, just pop it in the post direct to the laboratory and await your results. Our vets will review your results and contact you if a treatment is required.

In addition, through autumn & winter, our vets will visit and collect a blood sample to test for encysted small redworms that cannot be detected on a faecal worm egg count.
